- The yellow choker strap is adjustable, helping the worker to extend his reach in a safer manner. When the choker strap is disconnected, it functions the same as a standard pole strap.
- The Pole Choker can be fitted with a Jelco belt-mounted retractable device for climbing past an obstacle.
- The Pole Choker can also be used to secure a ladder to a neutral cable or to secure the worker to the ladder.
